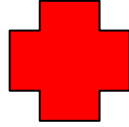
Welcome.....

Basic tips for your Safety



Take your time! Rushing is not worth getting hurt for life or losing your life.

Remember **fast is slow, slow is fast** - take your time! Rushing is not worth getting hurt for life or losing a limb or your life.

Drink plenty of water avoid caffeinated drinks.

Watch each other and use the buddy system don't let your buddy take risks that are not needed just to get done with the task sooner.

Wear long sleeve shirts when needed (working with insulation or around mold).

Wear work gloves, always.

Wear work boots, always.

Wear pants not shorts.

Watch where you step.

Wear a dust mask N-95 is minimal level for your protection.

Wear safety glasses.

Take frequent breaks during the heat of the day.

Wash your hands frequently especially before eating.

Use a good hand sanitizer to kill germs.

Immediately, if cut wash injured area well and cover with a sterile dressing so it doesn't get infected.
